HOW IT WORKS: DRESS REHEARSAL

Friday June 21, 2019

Dress Rehearsal is a fast-paced, pack-it-all-in day where your dancer will have the opportunity to practice their dance(s) on stage. This day is VERY important, both to help young dancers become comfortable with the stage and backstage area as well as for older dancers to help with spacing on stage.

Dancers in the 1:00 Show: Group A: Arrive at 3:00 Group B: Arrive at 3:15 Rehearsal Start: 3:30	Dancers in the 4:00 Show: Group A: Arrive at 5:30 Group B: Arrive at 5:45 Rehearsal Start: 6:00
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Please arrive in costume with hair and makeup done, but bring shoes separately. Dancers can change into correct shoes once they arrive. If your dancer is in more than one routine, check the schedule to see which dance goes first.

Dress rehearsal will run just like recital day! Group A dancers will arrive first and check in with the IA staff, where they will be escorted to the backstage waiting area for their group. Group B dancers will arrive 15 minutes before the start time and will sit with a parent in the audience. We will run all of the dances in order (going back to do a dance twice if necessary), and at intermission we will practice the Group A/Group B transition. Please send ONE parent to pick up your Group A dancer or drop off your Group B dancer to eliminate congestion in the hallway. After the last dance is finished, we will bring all dancers back on stage to practice the award presentation.

All dancers who are in one dance only will be dismissed from the stage (please send ONE parent up to the stage to eliminate congestion). Dancers in two or more dances will be dismissed from backstage.

IF YOUR DANCER IS IN MORE THAN ONE ROUTINE, please make sure they arrive on time for their first routine and have all costumes, accessories, and shoes with them when they arrive. Once they are done rehearsing for their first routine, they will be assisted backstage by our staff with any costume changes and will be taken back out for photos for their next routine, until they have rehearsed all of their pieces.

Food and drink are not allowed backstage at Zionsville High School. If dancers are in both rehearsals and have a break, they may eat in the Performing Arts Center lobby as long as they put clothes on over their costumes.

HOW IT WORKS: RECITAL DAY

Hooray, you've made it to recital day!

Please arrive in costume with hair and makeup done, but bring shoes separately. Dancers can change into correct shoes once they arrive. If your dancer is in more than one routine, check the schedule to see which dance they perform first.

Each dance is assigned a group, either A or B:

- **If your dancer is in Group A**, please arrive 20 minutes prior to performance time. When you arrive at Zionsville High School, you will take him or her to the backstage hallway (there will be signs pointing you in the right direction) to check in with the IA staff. We will keep them backstage until it is time for them to dance, then they will continue to wait backstage until intermission when they will be released to watch the second half from the audience (please only send one parent for pick up to avoid congestion in the hallway). At the end of the show, all dancers will be invited back up to the stage for the award presentation.
- **If your dancer is in Group B**, please arrive 15 minutes prior to performance time and have a seat in the audience. Your dancer will be able to watch the first half of the performance, then at intermission one parent will need to check in at the backstage hallway (follow the signs pointing you there). They will be checked in with the IA staff and will remain backstage until they dance, then come back onstage at the end for the award presentation.
- **If your dancer has dances in both halves of the show**, they will remain backstage for the entirety of the recital. Please make sure they have all costumes and pieces when they check in!
- Dancers who are in one routine only will be released from the stage at the end of the show. Dancers in two or more routines will be released from backstage. **Please send ONE parent for pick up to avoid congestion by the stage and in the hallways!**

IF YOUR DANCER IS IN MORE THAN ONE ROUTINE, please make sure they arrive ready for their first routine and have all costumes, accessories, and shoes with them when they arrive. Once they are done with each routine, they will be assisted backstage by our staff with any costume changes.

Parents are not allowed backstage for any reason. If you have any concerns, please speak to the staff at the check-in table and we will assist you!

Food and drink are not allowed backstage at Zionsville High School. If dancers are in both shows they may eat out in the lobby between shows. Dancers in Level I and higher may keep a water bottle **WITH A LID/CAP** in the dressing rooms.

Pro Tips for your BEST RECITAL EVER

Whether this is your first recital or your fifteenth, we know that it can feel a little chaotic. So we've consulted the pros and put together a quick list of tips to have your best recital ever!

1. **Be on time to dress rehearsal!** When everyone gets to rehearsal on time, you get more time on stage to rehearse your dance. Younger dancers especially can get nervous being in a new area without a parent, and the more chances they have to practice being backstage and doing their dance on stage, the more confident they'll be on recital day!
2. **Keep all of your things in your garment bag(s).** Each costume is sent home in a garment bag. All of the bags have an extra, handy-dandy pocket in the back that can be used for shoes, hair accessories, hairspray, bobby pins, and makeup bags (for older dancers). Keep everything you need for each dance in the garment bag with the costume, and you'll be sure not to forget anything! (And pack it early, don't wait until the last minute!)
3. **Arrive early to recital.** Doors will open to the auditorium 15 MINUTES before the show, and getting there early allows you to find the best seats, make sure your group can sit together, and have time to take some photos before the show!
4. **Plan your costume changes!** If you are in more than one dance, make sure you know which dances are in which order and plan out your costume changes! Layer your tights (if necessary), know what accessories go where, and be ready to change quickly! Make sure all of your costume pieces and shoes have your name in them to avoid backstage mix-ups!
5. **Relax and have fun!** Recital is all about showing off everything you've learned and how much fun you've had in dance class over the year! Remember everyone in the audience is rooting for you and wants to see you dance well! Smile big and light up the stage!
