

IMPORTANT NOTICE – COVID-19

Your health and wellbeing are our top priority. That is why we have adopted additional safety measures related to COVID-19. These updated procedures will remain in place until further notice. While no set of safety measures can guarantee COVID-19 will not be transmitted in our facilities or activities, these procedures were developed based on guidance from public health authorities such as the CDC and Indiana Department of Health, and we will continue to monitor relevant public health information and adopt additional measures pursuant to updated recommendations. It is important for you to become familiar with and abide by these important safety procedures for the protection of you, your family, and all of InterActive's families and employees. I: Employee, Visitor & Participant Temperature Screening Process:

All who enter our facility will be subject to temperature screening as follows:

- Upon entering the facility, each person will have his or her temperature taken.
- Anyone with a temperature of 100 or more will not be allowed in the facility, and may not return until his or her temp stays below 100 without the use of fever-reducing medication for 72 hours.

II. Enhanced Personal Hygiene Measures

- All adults (coaches and visitors) will be required to wear a mask when entering and exiting IA. Masks may be pulled down when coaching or watching classes if keeping 6 ft distance from other adults or athletes. Coaches will wear masks when they are spotting children and cannot distance 6 ft.
- All employees must wash their hands with soap and water regularly and thoroughly for 20 seconds, including at the beginning of each shift and upon returning from a break.
- Employees and all visitors will be reminded to avoid touching mouth, eyes and nose.
- Employees and participants will be reminded of proper etiquette when coughing or sneezing, including turning away from individuals and coughing/sneezing into their elbow.

III: Symptom Assessment Questionnaire:

By entering our facility, you are affirming that the following statements are true as to yourself and any minors accompanying you:

- I have not had coughing or shortness of breath in the last 14 days.
- I have not had **any two** of the following symptoms in the last 14 days: Fever of 100 or higher (actual or subjective, intermittent or constant); chills; repeated shaking with chills; muscle pain; headache; sore throat; or new loss of taste or smell.
- No member of my household, person for whom I provide care, or intimate partner has been diagnosed with or suspected to have COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- I have not had prolonged (more than 15 minutes) close contact (within 6 feet for 10 minutes or more without the use of personal protective equipment) with anyone diagnosed with or suspected to have COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- I have not had direct contact with the bodily secretions of anyone diagnosed with or suspected to have COVID-19 (e.g., being coughed on, touching used tissues with bare hand, sharing food or drink) in the past 14 days.
- I have not traveled outside of the country in the last 14 days.

IV. Enhanced Cleaning and Disinfecting Protocols for InterActive Academy

The following enhanced cleaning and disinfection protocols have been implemented and must be followed:

- Hand sanitization stations will be added through the facility.
- Disinfectant caddies will be placed around the facility to be accessible to our staff.
- Oxivir and Virex, hospital grade, CDC-approved cleaning products will be used on surfaces and equipment.
- Highly touched surfaces will be **cleaned multiple times each day.**
- Gym equipment will be cleaned **after each shift (morning and evening).**
- Water fountains are closed.
- Participants and visitors should wash hands and use the restroom prior to arriving, and come dressed and ready for training/work as bathrooms are available only if needed.
- One sink will be accessible at a time in the public restrooms.

V. Social Distancing Required

Social distancing and other related protections will be put into place:

- All employees, participants and visitors follow social distancing requirements established by the CDC, including maintaining six-foot social distancing.
- Classes and practice times will be staggered.
- Multiple entrances will be used for different programs.
- Participants may have one adult accompany them if needed into the facility.
- Chairs will be set six feet apart in our viewing area.
- Tables will be removed from the viewing area.
- Tape lines for class children will be replaced with dots to remain distanced.
- Dots and visual markers will be used in the gym to help participants in maintaining distance.
- Partitions at the main entrance to allow for distancing upon entering and exiting the facility.
- Payments accepted by credit/debit/ach only – no cash.
- Front desk assistance recommended via phone or email to prevent any lines at the front desk.
- **We will continue to focus on demonstrations and verbal corrections while instructing our kids and athletes. Our team coaches and class instructors will spot children as needed in the gym (masks while spotting). Obstacle courses will be utilized again to offer more stations for all classes and practices. Swim instructors will wear masks in the 1:1 lessons by parent recommendation.**
